Total Suspended Particles (**TSS**) is caused by individual particles that are generally invisible to the naked eye. TSS can be indicative of organic or inorganic matter, which can interfere with water disinfection, or even stimulate bacterial growth.

The measurement for TSS is, therefore, a key test of water quality. The most scientific way to measure turbidity is to report results in *NTU's*. **The EPA maximum allowable level for TSS, or turbidity, is 1.0 NTU, with 0.5 NTU required on a steady state basis.**

Using advanced **Nano-Ceramic Filters**, which are ECO friendly, American Water Systems' drinking water purification systems are uniquely designed to remove virtually all of the suspended solids or turbidity the water may contain, without removing good macro and trace minerals.

As part of our continuing water quality audit at your facility we measured the turbidity with a HANNA HI 93414 Turbidity Meter and Certify that on: October 27, 2010.
